As we begin to prepare for the 2022-2023 school year, we have exciting news to share with you regarding the grade level restructuring of two of our elementary schools and the elementary school times. Please see below for details.

Restructuring:

Beginning in September 2022, Oakview Elementary School and Red Bank Elementary School will begin serving students from kindergarten through second grade. The district believes restructuring kindergarten to second grade will continue to enhance our goals of instructional, social, and emotional continuity for our students, families, and staff. Specifically, the district will be assigning Oakview and Red Bank students based on their residential address, not their before and after school childcare location. To clarify, transportation will only be provided by the district to and from childcare within the area each individual school serves. The district will inform parents/guardians of the 2022-2023 kindergarten through second grade school assignments by June 17, 2022. Please know that the district will not accept requests for school assignments.

The district will host a Question and Answer Night for elementary families at Oakview Elementary School on Wednesday, May 25th from 6:00 pm - 6:45 pm in the All Purpose Room prior to the Elementary PTO meeting. If you have questions and are unable to attend the Q and A Night, please reach out to your child's building principal. Please Note: The Young Eagles before and after school program will continue to be offered at all 3 Elementary Schools.
